- To drive the all round development of all players, including the delivery of technical and tactical skills sessions
- To manage the members of the Essex cricket coaching structure, in both the Men and
 Women's pathway, whilst supporting the Club's Ability teams
- To support the professional development of coaches across the Essex Team programme



- To work with the staff to create a positive, welcoming and high performing culture within the Essex Teams
- To support and influence the player identification strategy, including recruitment,
 retention and selection
- To work with the Head of Performance Analysis to embed performance analysis within the training and match play environment
- To support the identification of players across the Essex Talent Development programme
- To work closely with the SSM team to support the availability, readiness and wellbeing of players
- To drive their own personal development and growth
- To undertake the required administrative duties including report writing and emailing as directed by General Manager
- To serve as a role model in conjunction with the Club's core values and strategic plans
- To undertake any other related duties that are deemed reasonable

- Support the development of cricket across the recreational game and the development of Essex as a sustainable and successful business
- Regularly communicate with local counties, clubs and other partners
- To work with other sports, or within the ECB coaching environment
